UPSC CSE EXAMINATION

UPSC conducts **Civil Services Examination** in 3 stages – Prelims, Mains, & Interviews. The Preliminary Exam is an objective type examination for the shortlisting of candidates, and the Mains Examination is a subjective type examination comprising of 9 descriptive exams. The candidates who qualify the Prelims examination become eligible for Mains exams. Candidates qualifying the Mains exam are called for Interview which is the final selection round. During this round, the candidates are evaluated for their observation skills, intelligence, alertness, balance of judgment and human qualities like honesty, morality and administration. There is high competition in **UPSC examination** and there are many education institutes available, as a result aspirants get confused. 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UPSC Optional Subjects

Union Public Service Commission conducts Civil Services Examination. UPSC conducts this examination in three stages Prelims, Mains and Interview. Lakhs of candidates apply for this UPSC CSE every year. Every aspirant has one common question: “Which optional subject should one select in UPSC?” And, in the second stage of the exams one must choose an optional subject. 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UPSC Exam Pattern

Preliminary Exams

- This is the screening stage of the Examination. Marks are not counted in the merit list.
- It comprises of 2 objective type question papers.
- 0.33% negative marking for each wrong answer.
- List of candidates to be qualified for Mains Exam will be based on the criterion of minimum qualifying marks of 33% in Paper- II (CSAT) and total qualifying marks of Paper-I (GS) or as determined by UPSC.
- Prelim is usually conducted in the month of June every year over one day.

Mains Exams

- This stage has 2 non-ranking but qualifying papers and 7 ranking type papers all of which will be of essay type.
- The non-ranking (qualifying) paper on Indian Language will not be compulsory for candidates hailing from the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland and Sikkim.
- Candidates will have the option to answer all the question papers, except the Qualifying Language papers, Paper - A & Paper - B, in any of the languages included in the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution of India or in English.
- Mains are usually conducted in the month of October every year over a span 5 days.

➤ General Studies & Optional Subject?

The major difference between the General Studies and the Optional Subject paper is the weightage of marks. In Optional subject, candidates are supposed to write much detailed answers and subject focused approach is required. Political Science & International Relations is a good example for optional versus General Studies Paper 2. Let's understand this better with an example, suppose there is a question on "challenges of democracy" in both papers then in that case students who have opted for General Studies would answer about the challenges to the concepts of democracy. They might discuss about the prevailing situation about democracy, various concepts of democracy, the challenges of democracy, the challenges as per the current model in practice, etc. The content of the answer will change according to the paper.
